The Orange County Office of Care Coordination is accepting applications for the Orange County Continuum of Care (CoC) Board expiring seats and seat vacancy:

Expiring Seats

Selected candidates for the CoC Board will serve a two-year term on the Orange CoC Board.

- One (1) seat for Public Housing Authority (PHA) representative. Must be filled by person with a minimum three (3) years of experience.
- One (1) seat for Homeless or Formerly Homeless Individual representative. Must be filled by person with lived experience of homelessness.
- One (1) seat for Domestic Violence Agency representative. Must be filled by persons with a minimum of three (3) years of experience.
- Three (3) seats for specified At-Large representatives. Must be filled by persons with a minimum three (3) years of experience in selected area of expertise:
 - At-Large Seat: Behavioral Health Expertise
 - At-Large Seat: Faith-Based Representation
 - At-Large Seat: Health Care Expertise
- Four (4) seats for At-Large representatives with Expertise on Homeless Services and/or Subpopulation focus. Must be filled by persons with a minimum three (3) years of experience in selected area of expertise:
 - Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC)
 - Diversion
 - LGBTQ
 - People with disabilities
 - Prevention
 - Rapid Rehousing
 - Older Adults

Selected candidate will fill a current seat vacancy and serve the remainder of the term from January 2023 through December 2023.

- One (1) seat for Expertise on Homeless Services of Families. Must be filled by person with a minimum three (3) years of experience.
