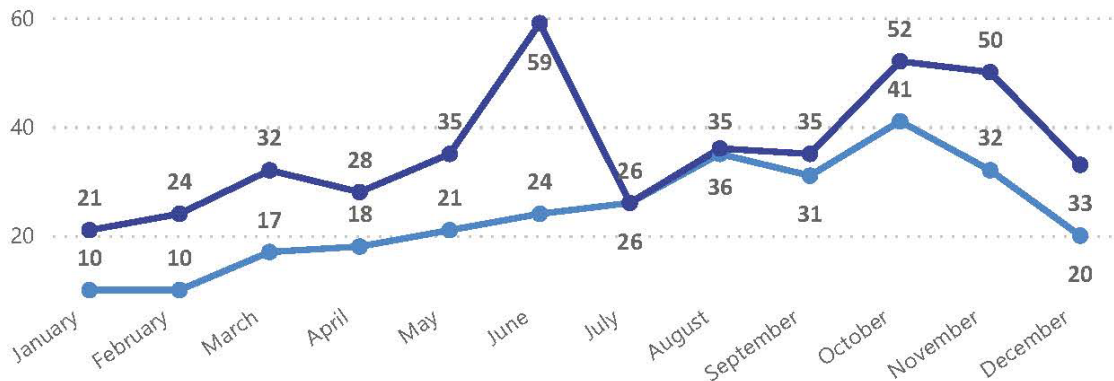

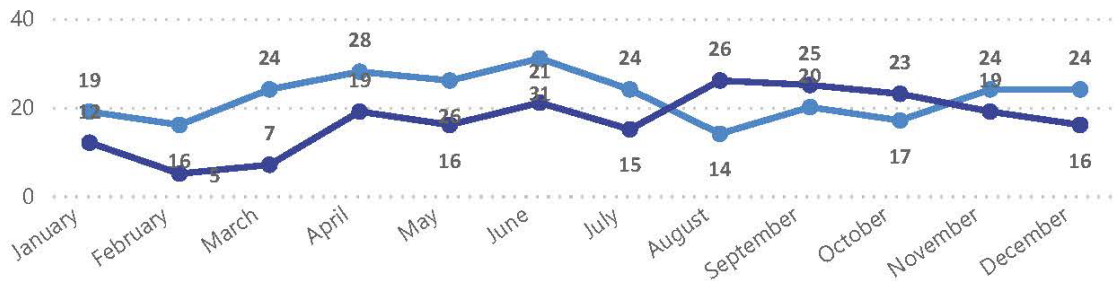
Inflow by Year

Year ● 2021 ● 2022

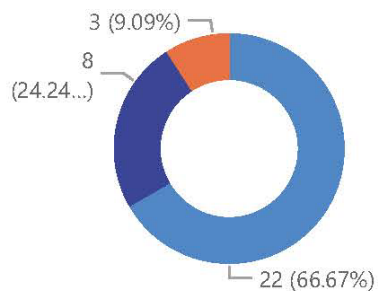


Outflow by Year

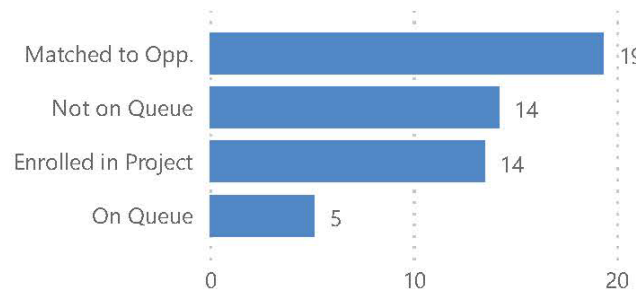

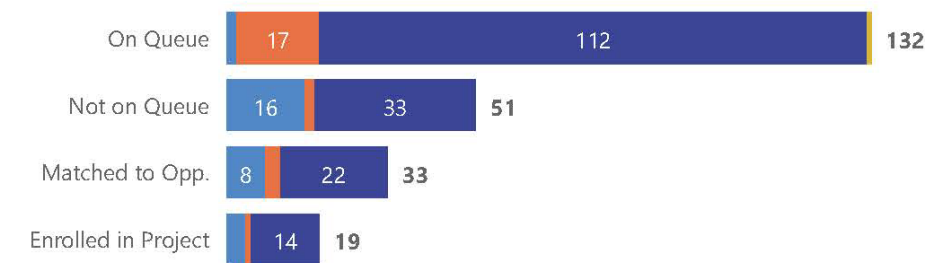

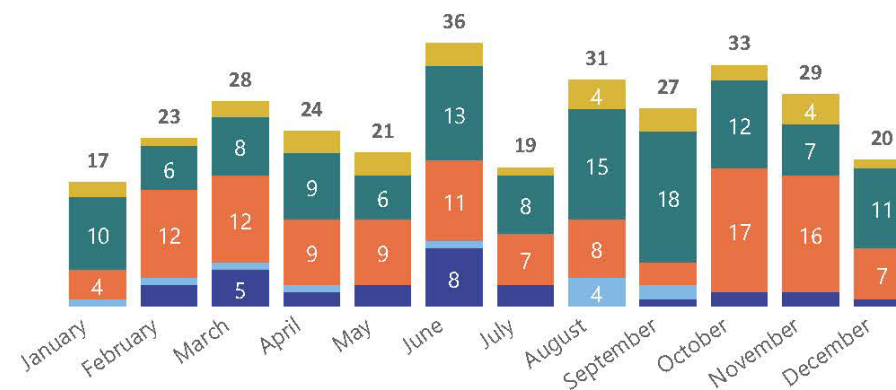
Service Planning Area Breakdown

Service Planning Area ● (Blank) ● Central SPA ● North SPA ● South SPA



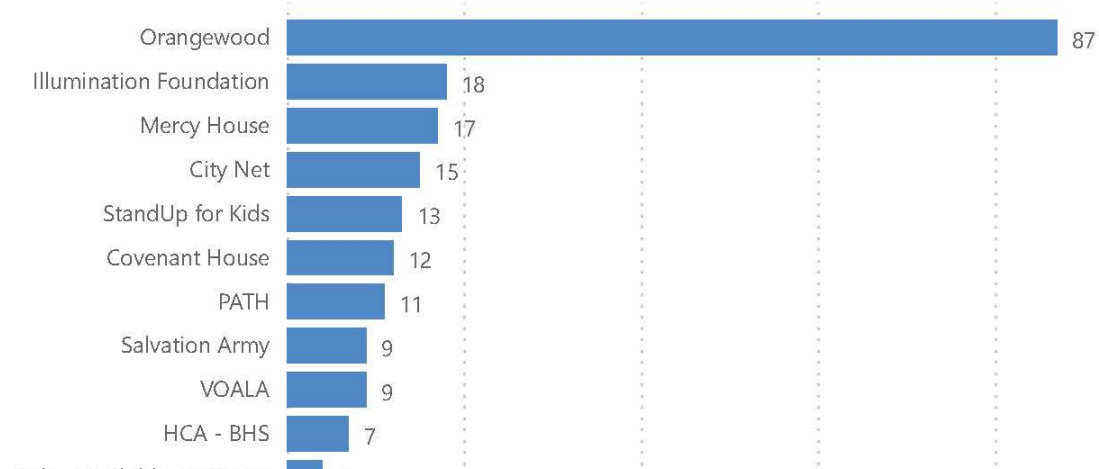

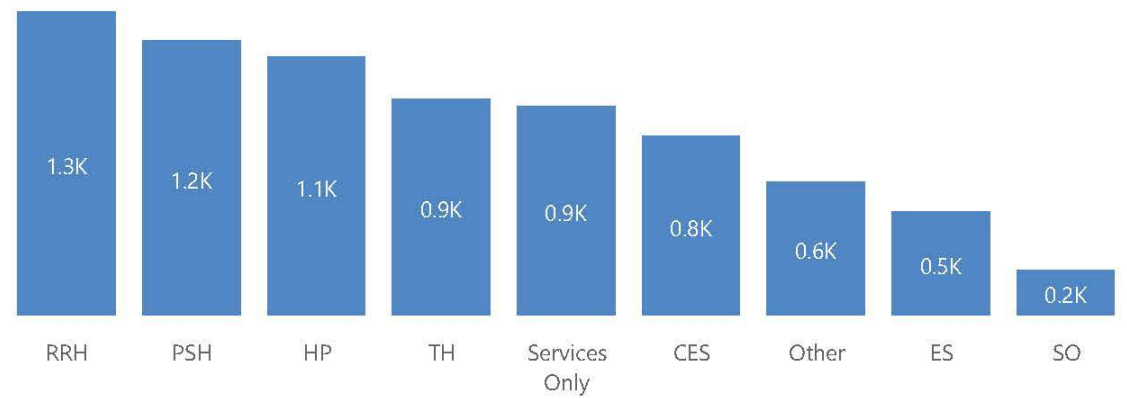


Transitional Aged Youth (TAY) Registry Overview: January 2023

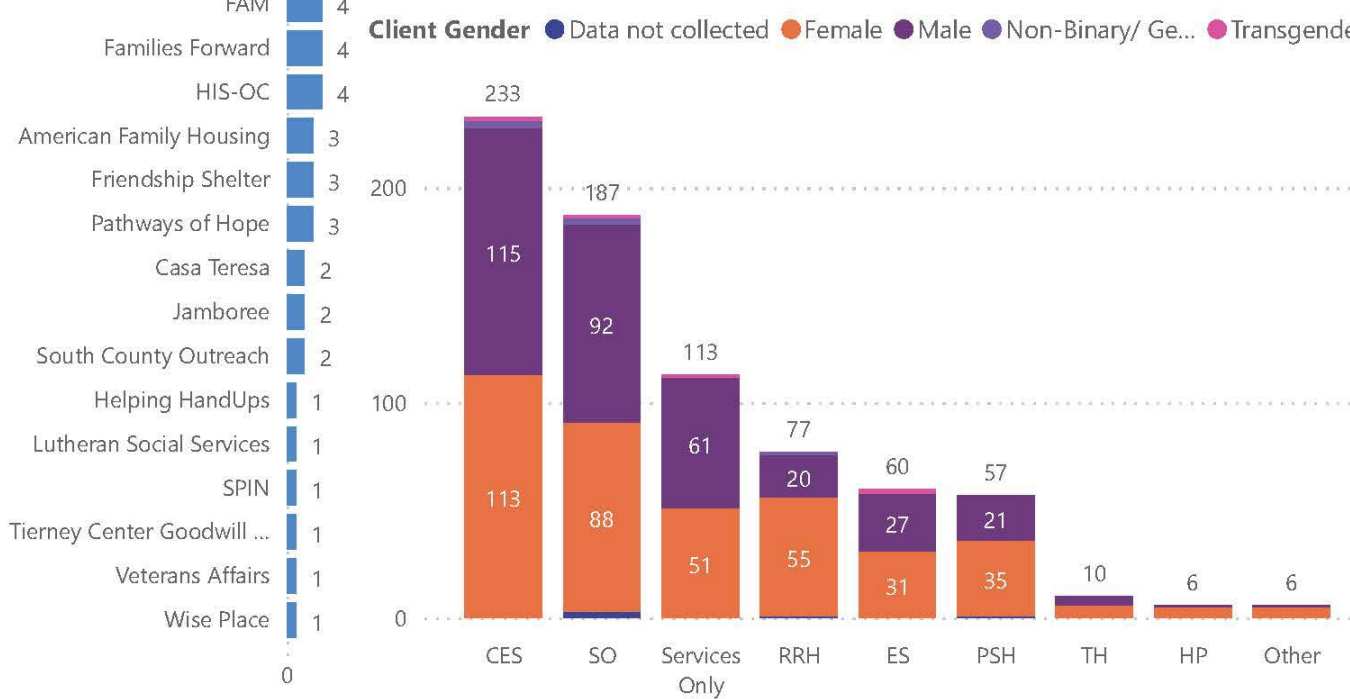
Access Points on TAY Registry



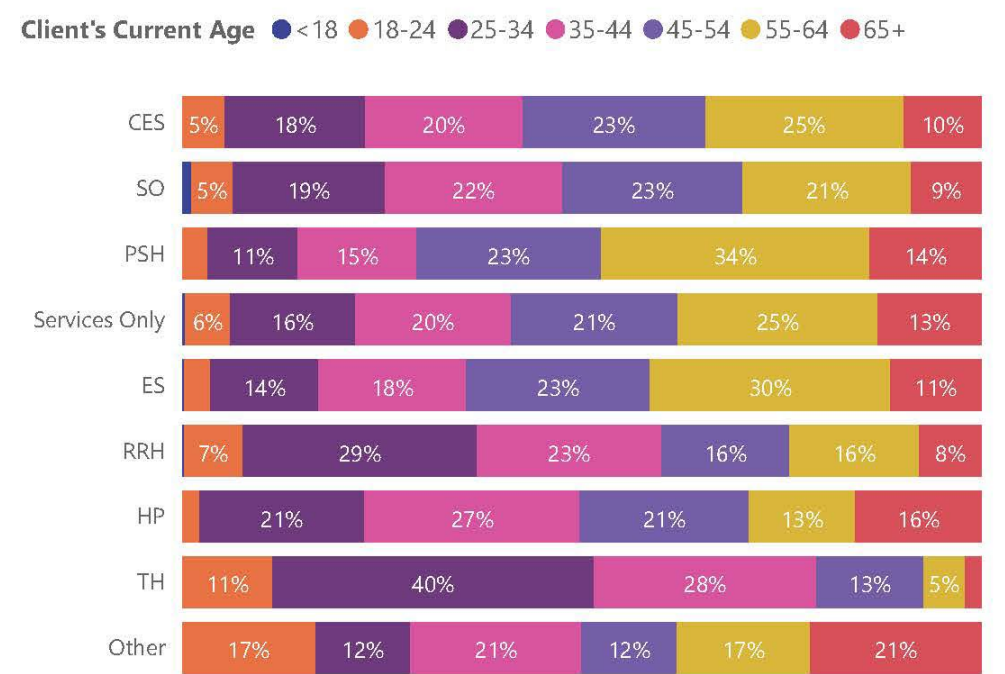
Avg Household Income



We are supporting the bridge into inspired and successful adulthood is the focus of all our efforts.



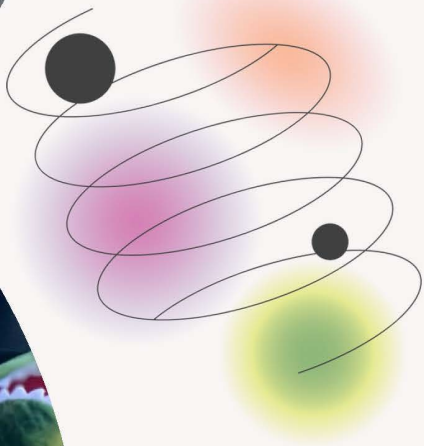
Program Services for TAY

- Active collaboration with Orangewood Foundation, CASA, Probation, Wrap Teams, and other community partners

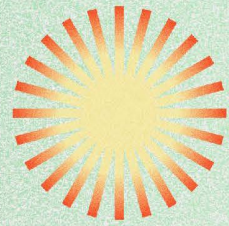




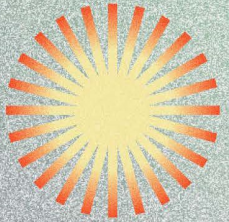
