- I. **Call to Order/Introductions/Opening Remarks:** Meeting called to order by OCCJCC Co-Chair Supervisor Andrew Do.  - a. VR Training Demo:
OCCR provided an in-house demonstration of the Virtual Reality Training Headset.
 - b. Housing Strategy:
OCCR shared the highlights from the updated County's Housing Strategy based on the 2022 Point-In-Time Count.
 - c. Cal Fresh Pre-Release Pilot:
SSA is currently partnered with Project Kinship to identify and engage individuals to be released within 30 days to enroll in Cal Fresh benefits.
 - d. Reentry Community Meetings:
Probation has hosted two meetings with Community-Based Organizations focused on reentry-type services which will be focused on specific topics, such as housing, substance use treatment, and mental health programs.
 - e. Quarterly Update:
CEO shared a high-level summary of the project status from the 2025 Vision

Quarterly Update for the period ending December 31, 2022.

Additional topics for future updates include the coordination of efforts to:

- Address jail release times or availability of engagement services during post-business hours;
- Provide consistent care management services across the Office of Care Coordination and contracted Full Service Partnerships.
