ASL Summary Sheet

The Alternative Sleeping Location (ASL) is an emergency shelter operated by Friendship Shelter. It is located in the canyon of Laguna Beach. The shelter is open 24/7 to enrolled guests.

The ASL serves 30 adult men and women in a congregate shelter setting. Guests are assigned a cot with a mat as well as a locker with a lock. Storage is limited to what fits in the locker and neatly under the guest's cot. Exceptions can be made for accessibility devices.

Guests are provided with three meals per day during scheduled mealtimes. There are showers, laundry facilities, and computers onsite for guest use.

Housing focused case management services are provided by assigned housing coordinators. A participant's stay is evaluated every 30 days and may be extended provided that the participant is actively working toward housing.
