As a person that has been directly impacted by houselessness I have a unique opportunity to address the ongoing housing crisis in Orange County. During my Doctorate program I specifically focused on Orange County's unhoused population. More specifically the stigma, discrimination and criminalization that the unhoused community faces daily. I will work to ensure that our unhoused neighbors voices are heard and their concerns are brought forward. Currently, I advocate on behalf of our unhoused neighbors to navigate the complex housing systems.

What qualities or characteristics do you bring to a collaborative environment?

I have worked with various stakeholders, including NGOs and public agencies to advocate for unhoused people to receive various services, including case management, vouchers, public assistance etc. During my Doctorate program I worked with various non-profits to create my Capstone program. I have been an advocate in Orange County for over 12 years working with various political stakeholders to fight for housing as a human right.

Permanently housing people that are experiencing houselessness within an efficient, and dignified system. I believe that every individual should have access to Permanent Supportive Housing under the Housing First program model. However, throughout Orange County individuals are being placed in PSH that is not being implemented correctly. Individuals that are placed under the PSH program model should be offered access to 24-hour case management services, low barrier/scattered site housing and immediate access to housing, and trauma informed care approach. If PSH was implemented correctly people would not face evictions or lose their housing. There needs to be accountability and transparency from the agencies that are offering these housing programs.

Please discuss one (1) significant challenge to addressing homelessness in Orange County. If you could wave a magic wand to address this challenge, what would your solution be?

The continued criminalization, stigma and discrimination that unhoused people face continues to perpetuate the houselessness crisis. Unhoused people are not allowed to exist outside in encampments and are not forced into shelters or jail. The continued carceral and punitive nature of shelters makes them unlivable for unhoused individuals. Moreover, shelters have become a long-term solution for unhoused individuals and it should not be. Most people in Orange County label unhoused individuals as lazy, drug addicts with mental health issues which dehumanizes the entire population. Unhoused people deserve to be treated with dignity, respect and empathy. I feel that these false stereotypes can be reversed through narrative storytelling.
