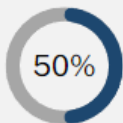
HATE CRIMES VS. HATE INCIDENTS



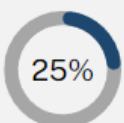

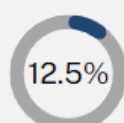

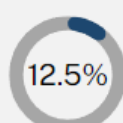
Sexual Orientation



Race/Ethnicity/National Origin

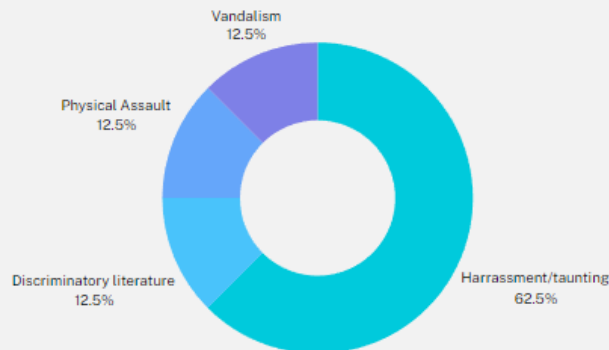

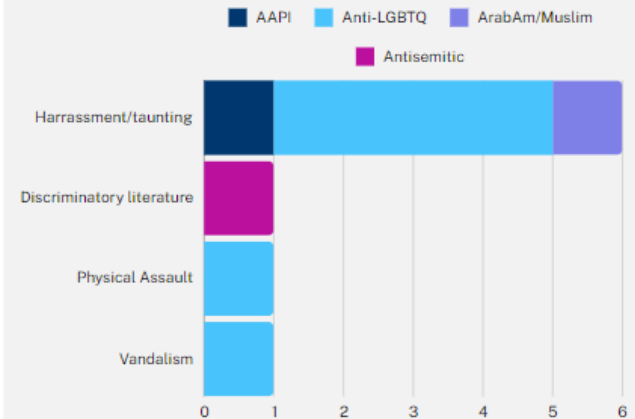
