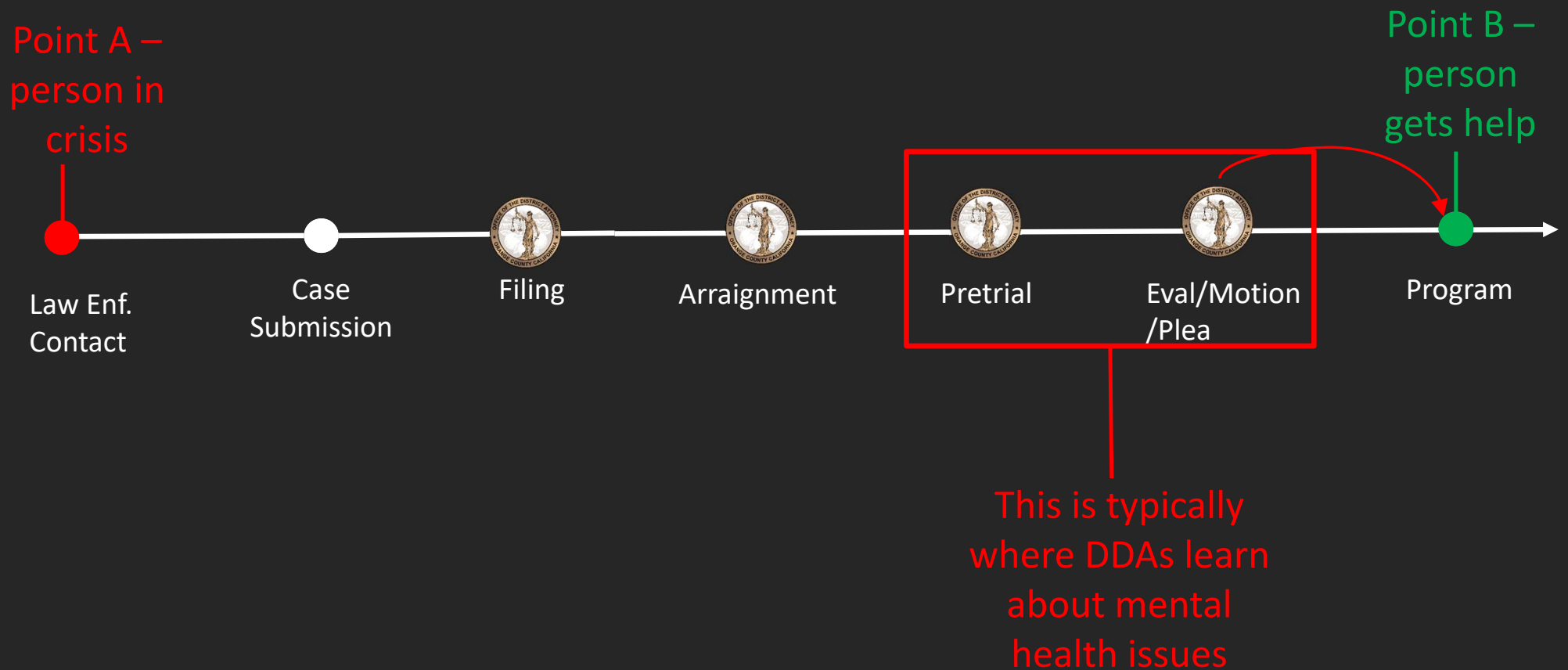

# Issue: Delayed Identification & Evaluation



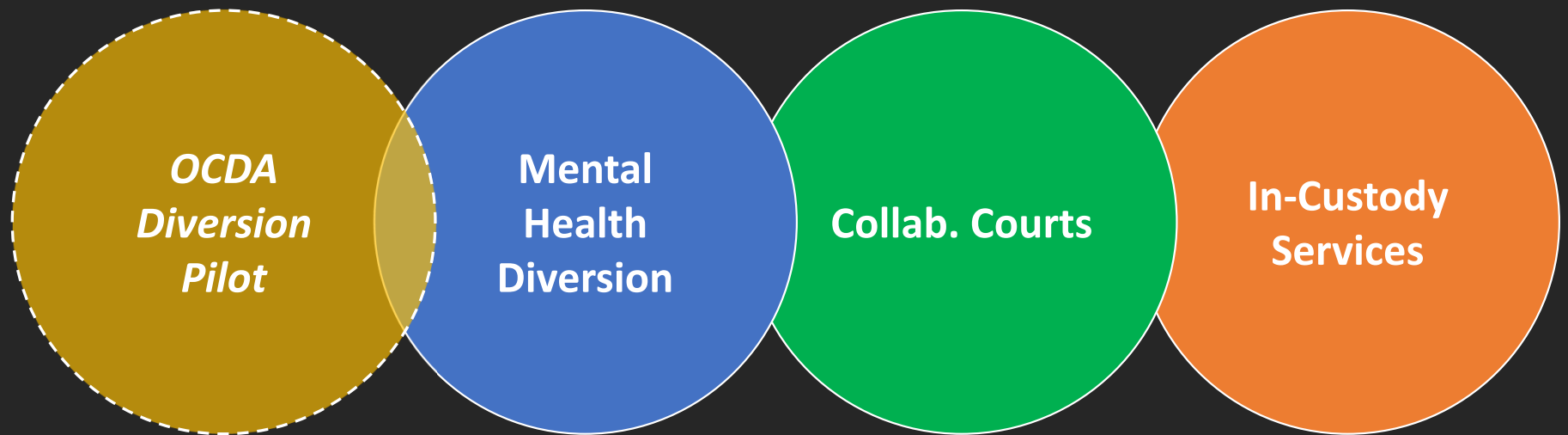

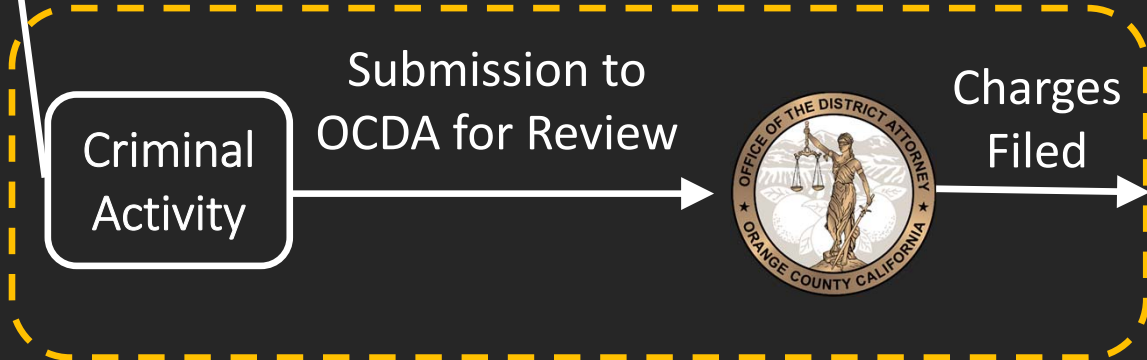

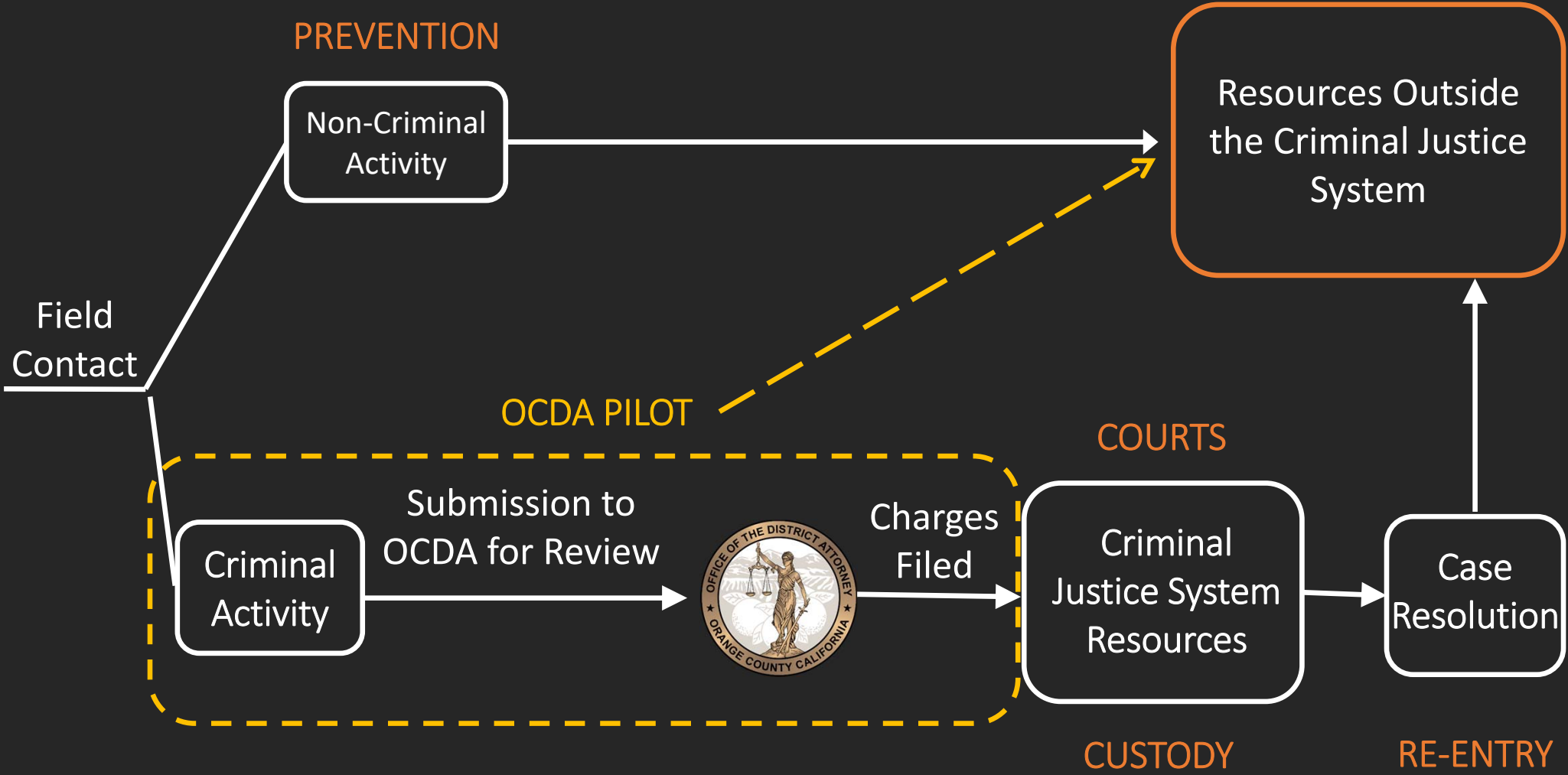
